Following the concept of "education for sustainable development", this platform aims to (a) raise people's awareness of the socio-economic and ecological impact of climate change and related issues and (b) motivate the public to adopt and campaign for a green(er), climate-friendly and socially just lifestyle. Being based on Harburg's Sustainability Portal, this website was recognised as an **"Official Project of the Decade 2013/14"** by the German UNESCO Commission (DUK) and is listed in Hamburg's educational Action Plan (HAP).

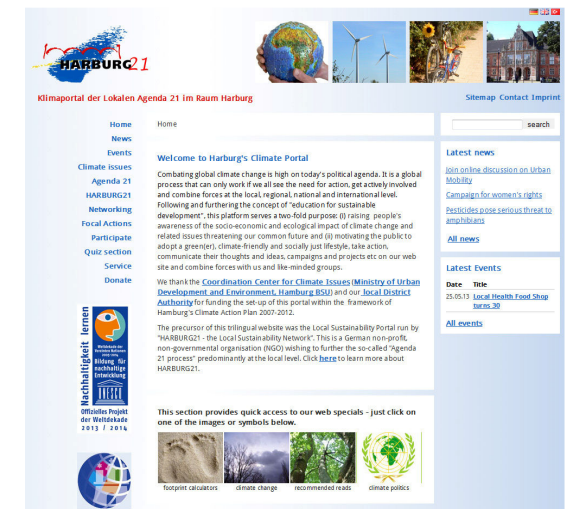
